# **E274 Hanging Basket & Planter Displays**

- Committee **AGREED** this year's planters will be in Jubilee theme of red, white, dark purple and silver. The planters will remain at their present locations.
- Committee **AGREED** that the Rotary can plant three concrete planters in Town in March 22. This will be included in the Town Council weekly watering contract which begins when the Towns hanging Baskets and planters are in place the summer. Feedback to the Rotary on the conditions on watering before our contract

begins, information on planting and the colour scheme selected and the media coverage.

#### E275 The Fenn

- A proposed Action Plan Meeting before April 22 with Essex Wildlife Trust was NOTED
- Committee discussed the perimeter fence around the Fenn. It was agreed this was at the age of needing maintenance and concerns were expressed regarding removing the boundary fencing and leaving the site as open access.

members to look at the areas need and consider repairs.

#### **E276 Trees on Ferrers Road**

It was **AGREED** to defer this item to the next meeting when the two White Poplar trees have been removed along Ferrers Road due to a Health & Safety risk in late January 2022.

#### **E277 Safer Essex Roads**

Following on from the launch of the Vision Zero Strategy document on 14/9/21 the reply from Essex COUNTY Council Highways was **NOTED**. Committee **NOTED** that a consultation with schools and residents to reduce the speed in school zones to 20mph will start over the next months.

## **E278 Eyotts Sea Wall Breach**

The update from Councillor Massey Essex County Council attached to the Environment Agenda was **NOTED**.

## **E279 Town Signage**

Committee discussed the repositioning or replacement of the Town sign at Millennium Place and new signage at the two gateways to the entrance of the Town.

**Proposal:** The Town Council to organise a Town competition for all residents in South Woodham Ferrers.

- To ask residents what location they would like the sign to be placed. The Committee will decide the winner and agree the location after April 2022.

Enquire into whether EWT have any river water quality data for SW and the Crouch

Think about new interpretation for the Fenn with a new focus and up-todate wildlife information

Get the EWT team to provide more information on what can be seen at the Fenn (pictures, information, stories, etc)

Councillor Bentley updated on letters being sent to the schools re using the Toolkit and Councillor Shearring updated on the work with the Marsh Farm Volunteers and coppicing/pruning of the apple trees at the Orchard.
